Qualifications for Park and Recreation Scholarships: (Need to qualify for at least one)

1. Recipient of free or reduced lunch program
2. Recipient of SSI (Supplemental Security Income) or Social Security Benefits.
3. Recipient of Medical Assistance Program.
4. Other (Explain)

Applications must be picked up at the **Park and Recreation Office, City Administration Building, 540 West Hills Circle**, and returned to the Park and Recreation Office prior to the start of the registration period.

Minimum fee of 40% of the program costs are requested upon acceptance of the scholarship. The scholarship fund will cover the other 60% of the fee.

The Scholarship Assistance Fund

The fund was originally set up by the family of Robin Macht as a memorial.

The fund was established for the purpose of providing opportunities to youth who might otherwise be unable to partake in programs offered by the Owatonna Park and Recreation Department.

The Scholarship Assistance Fund has the 501.C3 Status which is in the public interest to provide citizens the opportunity to make donations or memorials to this fund that are tax deductible.
